Dear Mr. Harris,

My Application for Stay or Injunctive Relief was docketed and denied by the Court on August 25, 2022.

As my petition, #21-1493, is still pending before this court, I submit 10 additional copies of my original Application, and a Proof of Service for sending copies of this letter to opposing counsel, pursuant to Rule 22.4.

I hereby request resubmission of this Application to Associate Justice Neil Gorsuch.

As the rights violations I experience are active and ongoing, I have also prepared a Motion to Supplement Application. As the Rules of the Court do not provide for supplements to Applications between their original consideration by the circuit justice and its resubmission, I have enclosed 13 copies of this motion -- 3 for the original application, and 10 for this re-submission. I hope this is acceptable. If it is not, please return solely the motion to me with your explanation, and just send the original application to Justice Gorsuch.

Additionally, I've realized your return letter to me for Application 22A181, dated August 17 2022, was "sloppy": your deputy clerk used the dates of denials of my petition #21-6444, but the title of #21-1493. I assume this was an honest mistake. Even if you have secret orders to be extraordinarily strict with my submissions to your office, in this case the ~10-day delay is quite helpful, as the developments in my Motion to Supplement did not take place until September 2 2022.
