I am counsel of record to Defendant in the above-captioned case. Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File Bill of Complaint in this case was filed on July 16, 2025. The Response in Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File Bill of complaint is currently due on Monday, September 15, 2025.

Defendant requests a 30-day extension of time, up to and including Wednesday, October 15, 2025. Counsel for plaintiff does not oppose this request.

There is good cause for granting this extension.
