I represent Respondent Javarrea Pouncey in this matter. On June 18, 2024, Petitioner Jarius Brown filed a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in this matter.

According to the Court's online docket and pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, the deadline to file a Brief in Opposition is currently July 22, 2024. Under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, Respondent Javarrea Pouncey respectfully requests that the time for filing a Brief in Opposition to the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in this matter be extended by thirty (30) days, to and including August 21, 2024.
