I represent PrimeSource Building Products, Inc. in the above-captioned case. PrimeSource was a plaintiff-appellee, aligned with Oman Fasteners LLC, in the Federal Circuit action that produced the judgment that is the subject of Oman Fasteners' petition for certiorari. PrimeSource agrees with Oman Fasteners that the Federal Circuit's decision is wrong, that Oman's petition should be granted, and that the judgment below should be reversed. Accordingly, PrimeSource is a respondent in support of petitioner in this case.

PrimeSource filed its own petition for a writ of certiorari to review the Federal Circuit's judgment in this case. *See* PrimeSource Fasteners LLC v. United States, No. 23-69. Although that petition was denied, PrimeSource files this paper in the above case pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 12.6 to preserve its right to qualify for any relief this Court may order in response to Oman Fastener's petition.
