I represent respondent Oman Fasteners, LLC in the above-captioned case. Oman Fasteners was a plaintiff-appellee—aligned with petitioner PrimeSource Building Products, Inc.—in the Federal Circuit action that produced the judgment that is the subject of PrimeSource’s petition for a writ of certiorari. Oman Fasteners agrees with petitioner that the Federal Circuit’s decision is wrong, that the petition for a writ of certiorari should be granted, and that the judgment of the court of appeals should be reversed. Oman Fasteners is a respondent in support of petitioner in this case.

Oman Fasteners is preparing its own petition for a writ of certiorari to the court of appeals arising from the same judgment. Oman Fasteners will file that petition within the timeframe permitted by 28 U.S.C. § 1259 and this Court’s Rule 13.
