Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, I am writing to respectfully request modest extensions of the parties' briefing deadlines in the above-captioned case. The Court granted certiorari on May 28, 2024, which would make the petitioner's opening brief and joint appendix due on July 12, 2024, and respondent's brief due on August 19, 2024.

San Francisco requests extensions to these deadlines that would accommodate the respective professional and personal obligations of the parties and their counsel while recognizing that the Court may schedule this case for oral argument during its October sitting. Under San Francisco's proposed schedule, the due date for petitioner's opening brief and the joint appendix would be extended to July 19, 2024, and the due date for respondent's brief would be extended to August 26, 2024. These dates reflect seven-day extensions for the filing of each party's principal brief and would make petitioner's reply brief due on September 25, 2024.

Counsel for respondent consents to this briefing schedule.
