RE: Rule 22.4 Emergency Application for Writ of Injunction *Sharma v. Circosta, et al.*, Dkt. No. 23A139

On 18th August 2023 The Honorable Chief Justice John Roberts denied Petitioner's Writ of Injunction. Pursuant to Rule 22.4 Petitioner respectfully re-submits this Application to the Honorable Justice Clarence Thomas, as he is the next senior justice.

The primary basis of why Petitioner is re-submitting the application is because a new fact has arisen in Case No. 23-5011, right after Petitioner filed 23A139, and Petitioner will even be denied Ballot-Access for the upcoming 2024 midterms for U.S. House of Representatives, because of indigency, of not being able to pay court fees as part of a parole sentence¹. Due to this Court's rules Petitioner cannot file a new injunction – therefore Petitioner believes it best to bring the new matter/fact to this Court's attention in this letter and refile the injunction.

Respondents in Case No. 23-5011 (Petitioner's Certiorari) have failed to file a waiver of response, thereby implicating a Justice to act on the merits via Emergency Docket; in Petitioner's scenario he was denied Ballot-Access for U.S. House of Representatives in District 13 of North Carolina for the 2022 midterms and is requesting a Special Election for the remainder of the 118th Congress. If relief is to be granted in Case No. 23-5011 then Petitioner believes it can be done on the Emergency Docket (23A139) to save time and to make sure relief will not be rendered moot when the Certiorari goes into circulation on 26th September 2023.
