DECLARATION OF Robert L. Shields

Honorable Supreme Court Clerk:

Please accept this as my motion for a 60 day extension of time to file my petition for a Writ of Certiorari with the Supreme Court, pursuant to U.S. Sup. Ct. R. 13.2.

I, Robert Lee Shields, declare:

1. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 2101(c); and, Rule 13.1, Supreme Court Rules, I have 90 days after entry of the judgment in the Court of Appeals to petition for a Writ of Certiorari. My 90 day deadline is August 1, 2023 and I cannot meet this deadline due to extraordinary circumstances at the United States Penitentiary,

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Victorville, where I am being held.

2. This facility (Victorville penitentiary) has experienced a rash of "lock-downs" that has literally kept me locked in a cell, without access to anything such as law library computer, printer, photo-copies, writing materials and stamps;
3. Not only does Victorville staff not provide prisoners with any of these items during "lock-downs," but myself and others are not permitted to purchase these items from the commissary during "lock-downs" either. I and other prisoners have not been allowed access to the commissary since May 30, 2023. As of this Declaration, it is now July 30, 2023.
4. Due to the foregoing, I am in dire need of a 60 day extension of time.
