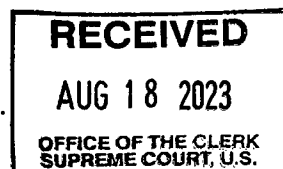

ORDER

Petitioner-Appellant filed a petition for rehearing and rehearing en banc on April 24, 2023. No judge\* in regular active service has requested a vote on the petition for rehearing en banc, and all the judges on the panel have voted to deny rehearing. Although Cosby filed several documents in this court, a motion for a certificate of appealability was not among them—except to the extent that a notice of appeal itself has that effect. Our disposition was therefore correct in construing the notice of appeal as Cosby's request for a certificate. The petition for rehearing is therefore DENIED.
