**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Petitioner, Tormu E. Prall (“Prall”), will apply for an extension of time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari. As grounds, the following is stated:

1. The petition for rehearing by the panel and Court en banc, was denied by the Third Circuit on May 25, 2023. The Prison Mailroom waited a month and a half to deliver that decision to Prall.


2. The LexisNexis and the Microsoft Word on the computers in the Prison Law Library were not working at the time the decision denying rehearing was delivered. Technicians are supposed to fix the problem on August 14, 2023.

3. Prall was unable to research the legal issues and legibly meet the August 25, 2023 deadline. He has bad handwriting. If Prall does not access the Law Library where he can type, his submissions are difficult, indeed, almost impossible to read.

### **CONCLUSION**

For all the foregoing reasons, the application to extend the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari should be granted.
