Dear Mr. Harris:

We write to advise the Court of a significant procedural development in the lower court in the above-captioned case.

As noted in our letter of yesterday, on September 25, 2023, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit issued an order granting panel rehearing.

Today, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit issued a new order, attached. This order withdraws the order of yesterday granting panel rehearing. The new order recalls the Fifth Circuit's mandate; orders the Government to respond to Plaintiffs-Appellees' Petition for Panel Rehearing by September 28, 2023, at 12:00 p.m.; and stays the district court's preliminary injunction pending resolution of the Petition for Panel Rehearing. *See* Order, No. 23-30445 (5th Cir. Sept. 26, 2023) (attached).
