6. Mr. Plummer timely appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the 3rd Circuit.

7. On or about May 18, 2023, the plaintiff filed an "Argument In Support of His Appeal."

8. On or about June 7, 2023, the 3rd Circuit Court of Appeals denied Mr. Plummer's "Argument In Support of His Appeal" request.

9. On or about July 20, 2023, Mr. Plummer, filed a Petition for Rehearing.
