1 DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR EXTENTION OF TIME
2 DUE TO INSTITUTIONAL SEARCH AND CURRENT MODIFIED LOCKDOWN

3 I, Raul Gardea Jr., am the Petitioner in the above-entitled case. In
4 support of my Motion for Extention of Time is the Institution's P.S.R. "Program
5 Status Report" attached as Exhibit A. The P.S.R. notifies the Staff and Inmate
6 Population the Plan of Operation.

7 Petitioner would like to define the difference between a General Library
8 User (GLU), and Primary Library User (PLU), found under the column Law Library
9 in the P.S.R. GLU would be for general use. The P.S.R. only honors/recognizes
10 PLU important which for this Institution only cocern's Inmate's that have a
11 deadline of 30 days. Nothing else.

12 This Plan of Operation was initiated May 22, 2023 to cover all yards in
13 the Institution each week per yard, i.e. (A,B,C,D) and an outside facility. Each
14 yard has 5 buildings with the exception of C-yard which has 6. Thus the search
15 was well over a month.

16 Currently, due to a death on this yard, this yard finds itself on a modi-
17 fied lockdown. Petitioner's C.O.A.'s denial found in Exhibit B, was filed May 12,
18 2023. Upon receiving the 9th Circuit's ruling VIA Postal Service, Petitioner
19 has not yet been able to set foot in the Law Library to access all relavent
20 Court Rules, proceedures, and available application's or detailed formating.
21 Because of my inability to access the Law Library, Petitioner is attaching to
22 the Exhibit's all original's.

23 Petitioner prays that this most Highest Honorable Court recognizes the
24 mere fundamental importance just to be able to access the printer itself, which
25 is only available to Inmate's at the Law Library for the necessaty to file not
26 just the duplicates of ones original documentation's, but the quantity of
27 duplicates for the parties involved as well. Petitioner is also hopefull that the
28 Clerk's Office supplies a helpful "Guide for prospective indigent Petitioner's
