I represent respondent in the above-captioned case. On August 6, 2026, the parties jointly requested extensions of the time to file the merits briefs and joint appendix as follows:

Brief for the petitioner and joint appendix	August 31, 2026
Brief for the respondent	October 19, 2026
Reply brief for the petitioner	November 18, 2026

The parties advised that this schedule would enable this case to be heard during the second week of the Court's December 2026 sitting, but if this case were assigned to the Court's January 2027 sitting, the parties may revisit this schedule and seek additional extensions of time. 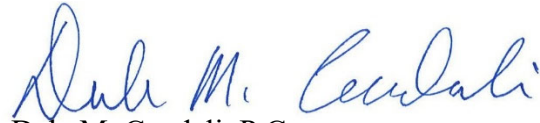
Brief for the petitioner and joint appendix	September 8, 2026
