Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent respondent Elizabeth M. Whitehorn in the above-captioned matter. The response to the petition for a writ of *certiorari* currently is due on August 15, 2025. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, respondent Whitehorn respectfully requests a 30-day extension of time, to September 15, 2025, to file her response. Counsel for petitioner has authorized me to state that petitioner does not oppose this request.

I request this extension because Assistant Attorney General Richard Huszagh, who is assigned to draft the brief in opposition for respondent Whitehorn under my supervision, requires additional time to draft that brief. In addition, my work responsibilities merit an extension of time to file the response. I am responsible for preparing respondents' brief on the merits in *Bost v. Illinois State Board of Elections*, No. 24-568 (U.S.), which is due on August 26, 2025. In addition, as the Illinois Solicitor General, I devote substantial time to performing supervisory and administrative duties, including editing briefs in numerous appeals and helping attorneys prepare for oral argument.

This is respondent Whitehorn's second request for an extension of time. It is not made for purposes of delay, but solely to ensure that her interests are adequately
