MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISPENSE WITH PREPARATION OF A JOINT APPENDIX

Pursuant to Rule 26.8 of the Rules of this Court, the Solicitor General, on behalf of the United States, respectfully seeks leave to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix in this case. The question presented is whether 18 U.S.C. 922(g)(3), the federal statute that prohibits the possession of firearms by a person who "is an unlawful user of or addicted to any controlled substance," violates the Second Amendment as applied to respondent. The opinion of the court of appeals, the order of the district court, and the report and recommendation of the magistrate judge are appended to the petition for a writ of certiorari. In our view, no other portion of the record merits special attention warranting the preparation and expense of a joint

appendix, and preparation of a joint appendix would not materially assist the Court's consideration of this case.

Counsel for respondent has consented to dispensing with the printing of a joint appendix.
