Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 32.3, I write to request that respondent the City of Los Angeles be permitted to lodge with the Court the complaint, answer, and judgment filed in the Los Angeles Superior Court in *Revere v. Mossanen*, No. 22STCV08231.
