**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner, ANDRE MICHAEL DUBOIS, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. Mr. Dubois was determined to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, by a judge of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia. Undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Mr. Dubois in the district court and on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

2. Mr. Dubois was arrested on January 30, 2020, and was released on bond on February 4, 2020. Mr. Dubois was found guilty after a jury trial on November 19, 2021, and remains indigent. Through counsel, he will file in this Court a *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* and wishes to do so *in forma pauperis*.

WHEREFORE Mr. Dubois asks this Court to grant his motion to allow him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
