### Petition for initial hearing En Banc

There are two narrow Circumstances that may justify initial hearing En Banc: (1) En Banc Consideration is necessary to secure or maintain Uniformity of the Court's decision or (2) the Proceeding involves a Question of exceptional importance.

Petitioner respectfully urges; ask this Court to grant hearing En Banc to decide two important issues of law related to Perkins Operation: Whether the deceptive interrogation tactics used in this Case violated the due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment, and they were lawful where they were used to deliberately Circumvent the Protection afforded to Godbolt Under the Fifth Amendment. On a related issue, En Banc should be granted to determine whether CoAppellants Perkins were testimonial. Even If the first Operation on ~~wise~~ Wise was investigatory, the Subsequent Operation On Godbolt and Ray were Primary aimed at gathering evidence for a Prosecution.
