ORDER

This matter comes before the Court upon review of Petitioner's motion for <u>nunc pro tunc</u> appointment of counsel pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act (Doc. #3, Motion), filed June 10, 2013. Counsel form the Capital Collateral Regional Counsel-South has represented Petitioner in his State post-conviction proceedings since 2003. Motion at 2. shall send a copy of this order and the attached CJA 30 form to William M. Hennis, III, and Neal Andre Dupree.

2. Counsel for Petitioner shall return the CJA-30 to the Court within sixty (60) days from the date on this Order.
