I am counsel of record for the Respondents in this matter. On January 2, 2025, this Court docketed the petition for writ of certiorari Petitioner Donald Sherman filed with this Court. The brief in opposition is currently due on March 17, 2025. Respondents respectfully request this Court issue an order under Rule 30.4, extending the deadline to file the brief in opposition by thirty (30) days, to and including April 16, 2025.
