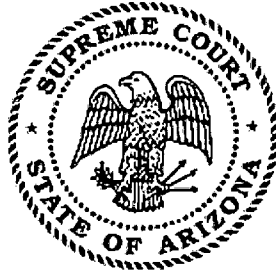

MEMORANDUM DECISION

Vice Chief Judge Staring authored the decision of the Court, in which Judge O'Neil and Judge Brearcliffe concurred.

STARING, Vice Chief Judge:

¶1 Petitioner Jesse Fulcher seeks review of the trial court's order dismissing his petition for post-conviction relief, filed pursuant to Rule 32, Ariz. R. Crim. P. "We will not disturb a trial court's ruling on a petition for post-conviction relief absent a clear abuse of discretion." *State v. Ainsworth*, 250 Ariz. 457, ¶ 1 (App. 2021) (quoting *State v. Swoopes*, 216 Ariz. 390, ¶ 4 (App. 2007)). Fulcher has not sustained his burden of establishing such abuse here.

¶2 After a bench trial, Fulcher was convicted of child molestation, four counts of sexual abuse of a minor, two counts of sexual abuse, and two counts of offering to transfer marijuana. The trial court imposed sentences totaling 42.5 years' imprisonment. The convictions and sentences were affirmed on appeal. *State v. Fulcher*, No. 1 CA-CR 20-0518 (Ariz. App. Sept. 9, 2021) (mem. decision).

¶3 Fulcher thereafter sought post-conviction relief, and counsel filed a notice stating he was unable to "find [a] colorable claim to raise." In a pro se petition, however, Fulcher argued he had been denied due process in various ways, including by the use of the terms "victim" and "breast" at trial and by the state's failure to disclose information as required by *Brady v. Maryland*, 373 U.S. 83 (1963). He also asserted he had received ineffective assistance of trial counsel because counsel failed to "object to the improper use of the term 'victim,'" to investigate certain evidence, and to "properly prepare for tr[ia]l." The trial court summarily denied some of these claims, but set an evidentiary hearing on Fulcher's claim that counsel had been ineffective in preparing for trial and his *Brady* claim. After the hearing, the court denied relief on these claims as well.

¶4 On review, Fulcher contends the trial court abused its discretion by "failing to adequately address" his claim related to the use of the word "victim" at trial and his claim that the state had violated Rule 15.1, Ariz. R. Crim. P., and the requirements of *Brady*. But Fulcher's claim as to

the use of the word “victim” and his claim pursuant to *Brady* are both claims raised under Rule 32.1(a), and are therefore precluded due to the failure to raise them on appeal. See Ariz. R. Crim. P. 32.2(a)(3). The court therefore did not abuse its discretion in dismissing those claims.¹ Cf. *State v. Perez*, 141 Ariz. 459, 464 (1984) (appellate court obliged to affirm trial court’s ruling if result legally correct for any reason).

¶5 Fulcher also argues the trial court denied him due process during the evidentiary hearing by “fail[ing] to maintain decorum” and by denying his request to reinstate counsel for the hearing. He asserts that the court allowed a witness—formerly an attorney in the Mohave County Attorney’s Office—to be “elusive, argument[at]ive, rude, and insulting.” Fulcher did not object to the witness’s statements at the hearing, which were made during his direct examination. See Ariz. R. Evid. 103(a) (party must timely object to admission of evidence); Ariz. R. Crim. P. 32.13(b) (rules of evidence apply at hearing). “A defendant generally waives his objection to testimony if he fails either to ask that it be stricken, with limiting instructions given, or to request a mistrial.” *State v. Ellison*, 213 Ariz. 116, ¶ 61 (2006). And “[b]ecause no court rule provides for fundamental error review of a petition for review to the appellate courts, such review is no[t] . . . required.” *State v. Smith*, 184 Ariz. 456, 459 (1996); see also *Swoopes*, 216 Ariz. 390, ¶¶ 41-42 (explaining “different principles” of waiver and fundamental error review apply in Rule 32 proceedings).

¶6 Furthermore, when an objection was made, the trial court acted to curtail the witness’s inappropriate statements. See Ariz. R. Evid. 611(a) (directing court to “exercise reasonable control” of the examining of witnesses). At one point, when the witness attempted to object on her own behalf, maintaining she had previously answered Fulcher’s question, the court overruled the “objection,” stating it was not sure it had been answered. Later, when the witness testified, “I don’t go on fishing expeditions for every single thing, so if you wanted something, it is your duty to put down the meth pipe and ask for something,” and Fulcher responded, the state objected to the exchange as argumentative. The court

¹Fulcher has not addressed his other claims for relief on review, and they are therefore waived. See Ariz. R. Crim. P. 32.16(c)(2)(D); *State v. Stefanovich*, 232 Ariz. 154, ¶ 16 (App. 2013) (defendant waived claim when he did not “develop the argument in any meaningful way” on review); *State v. Rodriguez*, 227 Ariz. 58, n.4 (App. 2010) (declining to address argument not raised in petition for review).

sustained that objection and directed Fulcher to ask his next question, noting, "[W]e're getting afield from what the relevant issues are." Fulcher has cited no authority to support his claim that the court was required to limit the witness's statements outside of the objections made. Indeed, we do not generally "require trial judges *sua sponte* to rule on issues not raised before them." *State v. Cannon*, 148 Ariz. 72, 76 (1985).

¶7 Fulcher further contends the trial court denied him due process by denying his motion to reinstate counsel. After Fulcher's appointed counsel had filed a notice stating he was unable to find any arguable claims to raise, the court granted Fulcher permission to file a pro se petition and ordered counsel to "remain in an advisory capacity." After the court set the evidentiary hearing, Fulcher moved to reinstate advisory counsel "as counsel of record." Noting that Fulcher had not cited any authority to establish his right to reappointment when counsel had found no colorable claim and that Rule 32.6² did not require counsel to do more than act as advisory counsel, the court denied the motion. It directed, however, that counsel be present at the evidentiary hearing in an advisory capacity.

¶8 Although Fulcher is correct in asserting on review that the trial court had the discretion to reappoint counsel under Rule 32.6, as a non-pleading defendant Fulcher had "no constitutional right to counsel in post-conviction proceedings." *State v. Escareno-Meraz*, 232 Ariz. 586, ¶ 4 (App. 2013). In the absence of supporting authority for Fulcher's request, and in view of the court's order for counsel to appear in an advisory capacity, we cannot say the court abused its discretion in denying the request.

¶9 We grant the petition for review but deny relief.

²The trial court erroneously cited Rule 33.6, Ariz. R. Crim. P., rather than Rule 32.6, but these rules are substantively the same.

The Defendant must also allege facts within his personal knowledge under oath, and support the allegations in the petition with affidavits, records, or other evidence currently available to him. One copy of the petition shall be served upon the Criminal Presiding Judge/ Rule 32 Management Unit, and one copy shall be served upon the attorney for the State. The Court advised the Defendant that failure to timely file the *Pro Per* Petition for Post-Conviction Relief may be grounds for dismissal.

3)The State's response to the petition shall be filed within 45 days after the petition is filed.

1. *Victim.* As used in this rule, a "victim" is defined in accordance with the definition provided in the Arizona Revised Statutes ~~as a person against whom a criminal offense as defined by 13-4401(6) has allegedly been committed, or the spouse, parent, lawful representative, or child of someone killed or incapacitated by the alleged criminal offense, except where the spouse, parent, lawful representative, or child is also the accused.~~ With regard to the rights to be notified and to be heard pursuant to this rule, a person ceases to be a victim upon the acquittal of the defendant or upon the dismissal of the charges against the defendant as a final disposition. If a victim is in custody for an offense, the victim's right to be heard pursuant to this rule is satisfied through affording the victim the opportunity to submit a written statement, where legally permissible and in the discretion of the court. A victim not in custody may exercise his or her right to be heard pursuant to this rule by appearing personally, or where legally permissible and in the discretion of the court, by submitting a written statement, an audiotape or videotape. The victims' rights of any corporation, partnership, association, or other similar legal entity shall be limited as provided by statute.

Rules of Criminal Procedure

Prefatory Comment to the 2018 Amendments

The 2018 amendments make extensive changes to the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure (“ARCrP”).

These amendments “restyle” the ARCrP in a manner similar to the 2017 restyling of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure. The 2018 version of the ARCrP adds informative titles and subheadings, which should make particular rules and sections easier to locate. By using clearer language and, if possible, plain English, these rules should be easier to understand. The restyled rules avoid long sentences, ambiguous terminology (such as the word “shall”), and legal jargon. These rules also use consistent formatting conventions and terminology.

The amended rules also include substantive changes, *including but not limited to the following*:

(a) Rule 1 has been extensively reorganized and revised to include a variety of provisions regarding the form of documents, service, and electronic filing. The changes are generally consistent with the 2017 amendments to the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

(b) Rule 7, which deals generally with release, conditions for release, and revocation of release, has been revised to conform to the recommendations of the FAIR Justice Task Force.

(c) An amendment to Rule 8.2 requires that a trial begin within 90 days after a court enters an order for a new trial under Rule 32 or in a collateral federal proceeding.

(d) A new Rule 11.8 provides a separate rule for the determination of a defendant’s mental status at the time of the offense. Currently, that inquiry is in the same rule, and subject to the same requirements, as a determination of a defendant’s competence to stand trial.

(e) New provisions were added to Rule 15 to augment a party’s disclosure obligations if the party intends to call a “cold” expert, i.e., a witness who will be testifying about general principles without reference to any of the facts of the case.

(f) The multiple hearing provisions in former Rule 16.3, 16.4, and 16.5—including provisions for an “omnibus” hearing—were replaced by a single Rule 16.3 governing pretrial conferences.

(g) Rule 20 was amended to permit a defendant to make a post-verdict motion for acquittal without having made such a motion before the close of the evidence.

(h) Former Rule 30 was abrogated because it is largely duplicative of the Superior Court Rules of Appellate Procedure-Criminal.

(i) Rule 31, which deals generally with appeals in criminal cases, has been extensively revised to conform the rule to changes made in 2015 and 2017 to the Arizona Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure.

(j) Rule 32.6 was amended to modify when a court must decide whether a Rule 32 petition should be summarily dismissed. In a noncapital case, the court must still rule within 20 days after the reply brief is due, but the amended rule permits the court to extend that deadline if good cause exists. The amendments also increases the time permitted for summary dismissal in a capital case to 60 days, and permits the court to extend that deadline if good cause exists to do so.

(k) Rule 32.12(d) was amended to remove the requirement that before ordering a post-conviction DNA testing, a court must find that the evidence is in a condition that allows DNA testing to be conducted. Given the current state of the art, such a determination cannot be made without actually performing the testing.

The wording of an amended rule may be very different, or only slightly different, from the rule that it replaces. The intent of these differences is to make the ARCrP more functional, and easier to understand and use. Prior case law continues to be authoritative, unless it would be inappropriate because of a new requirement or provision in these amended rules.

The amended rules attempt to incorporate substantive requirements previously contained within comments to the former ARCrP. Because of that, these amendments delete most of those comments, along with comments that have long ago outlived their usefulness. Parties may continue to refer to comments to pre-2018 versions of the ARCrP to the extent those comments still apply to these amended rules.

(b) **If an Arraignment Is Not Held.** If an arraignment is not held under Rule 14.5, the date of arraignment for the purpose of computing time is the date the defendant receives notice of the next court date under Rule 5.8.

(c) **Entry.** A court order is entered when the clerk files it.

Rule 1.4. Definitions

(a) **The Defendant.** "The defendant" is a person named as such in a complaint, indictment, or information. "The defendant" as used in these rules includes an arrested person who at the time of arrest is not named in a charging document. "The defendant" in the context of certain rules includes the attorney who represents the defendant.

(b) **Limited Jurisdiction Court.** A "limited jurisdiction court" is a justice court under A.R.S. §§ 22-101 et seq., or a municipal court under A.R.S. §§ 22-401 et seq.

(c) **Magistrate.** "Magistrate" means an officer having power to issue a warrant for the arrest of a person charged with a public offense and includes the Chief Justice and justices of the Supreme Court, judges of the superior court, judges of the court of appeals, justices of the peace, and judges of a municipal court.

(d) **Parties.** "Parties" means the State of Arizona and the defendants in a case. Use of the word "party" in these rules means either, or any, party.

(e) **Person.** "Person" includes an entity.

(f) **Presiding Judge.**

(1) *For the Superior Court.* The superior court presiding judge is the county's presiding judge. In a county that has only one superior court judge, that judge is the presiding judge. In other counties, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court designates the presiding judge, who may appoint other judges to carry out one or more of the presiding judge's duties.

(2) *For a Limited Jurisdiction Court.* If a court consists only of one judge, that judge is the presiding judge. In courts having more than one judge, the presiding judge is designated by the appropriate authority.

(g) **The State.** "The State" means the State of Arizona, or any other Arizona state or local governmental entity that files a criminal charge in an Arizona court. "The State" in the context of certain rules includes the prosecutor representing the State.

(h) **Victim.** "Victim" means a person as defined in A.R.S. § 13-4401.

Tara was able to find out that Logan is 23 years old and Logan lives in Greencastle PA. Tara advised Kayla and Logan have been exchanging messages since October 2017.

Tara gave me consent to read the messages between Kayla and Logan. I observed the following:

- Kayla told Logan that she was 16.
- Logan advised that he was 23.
- Kayla sent Logan several pictures of her in her bra and panties.
- Logan advised that he likes "flirting" with Kayla.
- Kayla sent Logan a picture of herself with no bra while covering her nipples.
- Logan sent a message to Kayla stating he wants Kayla to "slide on his dick"
- Logan requested Kayla send him a picture while she is showering.
- Logan's phone number is **Privacy Interest**

Case Assignment

On December 7, 2017, I reviewed this case for possible leads and evidence.

While reviewing this case I read Tara Thorne reported a 23 year old male named Logan Wilhide was trying to lure her 13 year old daughter Kayla Ciampoli to Greencastle, Pennsylvania to perform sexual acts.

Attached to the original report was consent to search form filled out by Tara Thorne. Kayla iphone 5s was placed into evidence waiting for it to be examined.

On December 19, 2017, I received Kayla's iphone and looked through the iFunny application in the phone where the victim's mother said the conversations took place.

I saw the message started in early November 2017 and the last message was received on December 6, 2017. The last message read, "come take a break and have a nakey make out sesh with me".

As I read through the hundreds of text messages between the two them I read a male with the username [Privacy Interest] identifies himself as Logan Wilhide who is 21 years old and lives in

Logan asked Kayla how old she is and Kayla states she is 16 years old. Logan text her stating he is glad to hear that because the legal age of consent in Pennsylvania is 16 years old. Kayla never told him her real age of 13 years old but does state she is from Arizona.

They exchange several photos of their faces. Later in the conversations, Kayla mentions that she has been taking photos for a page called "[Privacy Interest]". Kayla photos consist of her in different positions in a purple leotard and two photos topless with her

covering her breast with her hands. Kayla sends the photos to Logan in the iFunny application.

Logan's text messages continue to be sexual in nature. Logan tells Kayla he is going to use a vibrating butt plug while he uses his long dick in her. At one point in the conversations, he tells Kayla he wants her to slide on his dick.

INTERVIEW WITH KAYLA CIAMPOLI

On January 18, 2018, I met with Kayla Ciampoli and her step dad Thomas Thorne at the Bullhead City Police Department for an interview.

The following is a summary of a recorded forensic interview with Kayla Ciampoli.

In general, while conducting a forensic interview, I establish a language sample by talking about subject matter not related to the incident, to build a rapport, and get a feel for how the victim communicates and recalls memory. I explain to the victim that I ask a lot of questions to better understand what they are telling me and I may ask the same question because I may forget that I asked it already. I request that the victim(s) let me know if I ask a question or say a word they don't understand and I will try to say it or ask it in a different way. I tell them they can use whatever language necessary to explain themselves no matter how embarrassing or inappropriate it may seem to them, as long as it is fact. I tell them that I will often summarize and repeat what they had told me and I request that if I make a mistake that they let me know so that I don't get it wrong. I express to them that if they did not know an answer to a question, to say that they "don't know" and if indeed that was the truth also I don't want them to give me an answer they think I want to hear and not to make anything up. I tell the victim that I only want to talk about the truth and things that really happened.

While building rapport with Kayla, she told me she is 14 years old and is currently being homeschooled. Kayla said she used to go to Privacy Interest School. Kayla said she is now homeschooled because her classmates bullied her.

After building rapport with Kayla, I asked her if she knows why she was there to speak with me. Kayla said yes, because she was on an app called ifunny on her phone. Kayla said she started a relationship with a male who was in his twenties and she told him she

was 16 years old. I told Kayla to tell me more about the ifunny application. Kayla said it's an application where you can post a meme on the app and it has a direct chat inside the app. Kayla said one day she received a message from Logan asking if he knew her. Kayla said Logan was nice to chat with but he was weird. Kayla said she would make sexual remarks during their normal conversation. Kayla said he would ask her if she was a girl, he had sex with in the past. Kayla said no. Logan replies with something like are you sure; you look like a girl who gave me head once.

Kayla said they exchanged text messages in the chat for approximately two months. Kayla said the text would go on all day, every day for approximately two months. Kayla said they talked about art, music, personal family issues. Kayla said she told him she lived in Arizona but never what city. Kayla said he told her he lived in Greencastle, Pennsylvania.

Kayla said they did talk on FaceTime and they did talk on the phone a few times. Kayla gave me the phone number of [Privacy Interest] Kayla said during one of their session of Face Timing, Logan showed Kayla his penis. Kayla said Logan flashed his "dick" for approximately 5 seconds.

Kayla said Logan sent her a fan sign. Kayla said a fan sign is a photo of someone's body part with the other person's users name in the photo. Kayla said Logan sent her a fan sign of her upper thigh with her user name on it. Kayla said in the fan sign photo she could see the outline of Logan penis under his shorts.

Kayla said she also send a fan sign to Logan: the photo was of Logan's username on a sign that covered her beast with no shirt on underneath. Kayla said they never sent each other any nude photos.

I asked Kayla if Logan ever asked her to have sex with him. Kayla said no, he only made comments like "I can't wait for you to suck my dick".

I asked Kayla if she talk to anyone else on any other application. Kayla said no.

I asked Kayla why she and Logan stopped texting each other. Kayla said her mom found out and told her she was going to call the police.

"Nxicoo" responded with "I'm close to cumming can you send a pic of your face" , "I know the thought of me jerking off to you every night turns you on" , and "Wanna see my cum?". Kayla respond to Nxicoo to stop harassing her and to stop messaging her. Nxicoo messaged Kayla and said that he sees her almost everyday.

Tara provided me with the screenshots of all messages sent between Kayla and Nxicoo.

Tara said that she had recently filed a police report against Jesse Scott Fulcher. Tara advised that Ofc. Fletcher took the report and she believed that Jesse may be sending these message to Kayla. (see report 19-01900)

Kayla was at work in Laughlin, NV. I was unable to speak with Kayla directly. Tara stated that she wanted to report the incident due to the ongoing investigation by Ofc. Fletcher. I advised Tara that I would inform Ofc. Fletcher of what occurred and I would pull my own separate report.

I asked Tara if Kayla had anyone that might know her that would be doing this. Tara said no and that Kayla was in good graces with all her friends. Tara also advised that Kayla was heavily active in community events and knows a lot of people.

I advised Tara that I would attempt to speak with Jesse to ascertain if he was involved.
