MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

TO THE HONORABLE COURT:

Petitioner, **Jose Padilla-Galarza**, respectfully moves for leave to proceed **in forma pauperis** pursuant to **Rule 39 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States**.
