MOTION TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Petitioner Jeffrey Hutchinson moves, pursuant to Rule 39, to proceed in forma pauperis (IFP) in connection with the concurrently filed application for a stay of execution and petition for a writ of certiorari. Petitioner is an indigent prisoner on Florida's death row who is scheduled to be executed on May 1, 2025.

Petitioner was previously granted IFP status by Florida's state and federal courts. Counsel of record for Petitioner in this Court, the Capital Habeas Unit of the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida, was appointed to represent Petitioner by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Florida, under 18 U.S.C. § 3599, on December 11, 2014.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, Petitioner respectfully requests that he be allowed to proceed IFP in these proceedings.
