The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

DAVID LITTLE v. THE STATE.

On September 23, 2024, the Court of Appeals affirmed petitioner's convictions for aggravated battery and cruelty to children in the third degree. Petitioner did not file a motion for reconsideration in the Court of Appeals or obtain an extension of time in this Court to file a petition for writ of certiorari. Therefore, his petition was required to be filed by October 14, 2024. See Supreme Ct. R. 38 (2); OCGA § 1-3-1 (d) (3). However, petitioner did not file his petition in this Court until October 21, 2024, making his petition untimely. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
