The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on May 27, 2025, and placed on the docket on June 3, 2025. On July 11, 2025, the Court requested a response to be filed. The government's response is now due, after two extensions, on October 10, 2025. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension to and including November 10, 2025, within which to file the government's response.
