Re: Montana v. Planned Parenthood of Montana, No. 24-745

Dear Mr. Harris:

I was recently retained to represent respondents Planned Parenthood of Montana and Samuel Dickman, M.D. in the above-captioned case. The petition for a writ of certiorari in this case was filed on January 10, 2025, and placed on the docket on January 14, 2025. The Court called for a response on February 28, 2025. Respondents requested a 30-day extension to and including April 30, 2025, and the Court granted that request on March 24, 2025. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondents now respectfully request a second 30-day extension to and including May 30, 2025.

An extension is warranted to provide counsel for respondents with adequate time to prepare a response to the petition. As noted, my firm was recently retained in this matter, and my colleagues and I therefore need additional time to familiarize ourselves with the record and arguments in this proceeding. We also have several commitments in the coming month that will make it challenging to complete the response within the allotted timeframe. Respondents therefore request that the Court extend the deadline for filing a response by 30 days, to and including May 30, 2025.

Counsel for respondents has communicated with counsel for petitioners, and petitioners do not object to the requested extension.
