Dear Mr. Harris:

I write to request an unopposed thirty-day extension of the time to file a response to the petition for certiorari in this case. The response is currently due on March 20, 2025, and I respectfully request that the deadline be extended to, and include, April 21, 2025. This is the second extension requested for this response. The petitioner consents to this request based on the respondent's representation that the respondent will not seek any further extensions of this deadline.

There is good cause for this request. My colleagues and I are heavily engaged with other appellate matters that would make it difficult to prepare a brief absent an extension. These deadlines include: an opening brief due in the Eighth Circuit in Ficke-Stifter v. MidCountry Bank, No. 24-3312, on March 5, 2025; an oral argument on a motion to stay in the D.C. Circuit in Wilcox v. Trump, No. 25-5057, on March 18, 2025; a response brief due in this Court in Labcorp. v. Davis, No. 24-304, on March 31, 2025; a respondent's brief due in the California Court of Appeals in Clinton v. Amazon Logistics, Inc., No. G064704, on April 14, 2025; and a response to petition for rehearing due in the Ninth Circuit in Nwauzor v. GEO Group, Inc., No. 21-36024, on April 17, 2025.

For these reasons, my colleagues and I will require additional time to prepare an adequate response to the petition. A thirty-day extension will allow us to balance these other responsibilities with our obligations in this case. In addition, the respondent will not seek any further extensions of this deadline.
