I write on behalf of petitioners in the above-captioned case, which was distributed earlier today for the Court's January 9, 2026, conference.

I write to inform the Court that the district court's dismissal of the complaint in this case was with prejudice, foreclosing further amendments to the pleadings. See *Amarin Pharma, Inc. v. Hikma Pharms. USA Inc.*, No. 20-1630, Dkt. 144 (D. Del. Oct. 13, 2022) (enclosed). This clarification is pertinent to page 12 of respondent's supplemental brief, which characterizes the underlying decision as "interlocutory" and adverts to the possibility of "a remand with leave for Amarin to amend the Complaint."
