Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on February 19, 2026. The government's response is now due on March 27, 2026. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, an extension of time to and including May 26, 2026, within which to file a response. Petitioners consent to the requested extension.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of previously assigned matters with proximate due dates. This extension also aligns the date for the government's response in this case with the respondent due dates in the related cases of 25-1017 and 25-1019. And as there, the requested extension here will allow the Court to dispose of the petition prior to the summer recess.
