
As counsel of record for respondent in the above-referenced matter, I am writing to request a 31-day extension of time within which to file a response to the certiorari petition to and including Monday, May 4, 2026. The certiorari petition was filed and docketed on February 27, 2026. Without the requested extension, the brief in response would be due on April 3, 2026.

The requested extension to file a response to the certiorari petition is necessary because respondents anticipate an order from the Missouri judgment court that will provide clarity as to whether a decision in *Monsanto v. Durnell*, No. 24-1068, (oral argument scheduled for April 27, 2026) will have any impact on the underlying, stand-alone design defect liability judgment rendered by the Missouri trial court and affirmed on appeal and which is now final as to that issue for purposes of state law. Respondents believe that a decision in that matter will occur prior to the expiration of the extension requested. In addition, the oral argument in *Durnell* may further assist in refining the issues presented.

With the extension, the response to be filed by the respondents will better assist the Court in defining and potentially limiting the issues presented by the Petitioners.
