On March 24, 2026, the Court requested a response from respondents regarding the subject petition for a writ of certiorari. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request that their time to file such response be extended by 60 days from April 23 to and including June 22, 2026. Although petitioners have advised the undersigned that they oppose a 60-day extension, petitioners sought and were granted a 60-day extension for the time in which to file their petition, which respondents did not oppose.

This request is justified because of the need for additional time to prepare a response to the petition. While the matter will be prioritized, additional time is necessary due to overlapping filing deadlines for a significant number of federal and state appellate briefs in other matters; the considerable internal review of the response that will precede the response's filing; and the need to coordinate with multiple reviewers.
