Dear Mr. Harris:

I write to provide a brief clarification of Petitioners' position on Respondents' extension request, dated April 13, 2026.

When Respondents' counsel requested Petitioners' consent to the extension, the undersigned responded that although Petitioners oppose a 60-day extension, Petitioners consent to a 30-day extension for Respondents' opposition. The principal basis for this position is to ensure the Court may conference on the Petition prior to its summer recess.

Of course, Petitioners defer to the discretion of the Court on the appropriate disposition of the motion. Petitioners respectfully request that the extension be for 30 days, or for a date that would permit conference of the Petition prior to the summer recess.
