Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent Respondent Transource Pennsylvania, LLC, in the case referenced above. Petitioners filed a petition for a writ of certiorari on March 16, 2026, and this matter was placed on the docket on March 18, 2026. Respondent's brief in opposition is due on April 17, 2026. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, I write to request a fourteen (14) day extension of time to file a brief in opposition to the petition. Respondent has not previously sought an extension of time in this case.

In light of the press of other business, undersigned counsel requires additional time to fully respond to the arguments presented in the petition, as well as any amicus briefs that may be filed. Between the petition's filing and the current April 17, 2026 due date, counsel has been responsible for presenting oral argument in *Syracuse University v. City of Syracuse*, No. 25-965 (N.Y. App. Div.); for preparing appellate briefs in *Michigan v. Department of Energy*, No. 25-1159 *et seq.* (D.C. Cir.); for preparing a motion to dismiss in *Wolverine Pipe Line Co. v. Commonwealth Edison Co.*, No. 25-cv-15627 (N.D. Ill.); and for preparing a complaint in *International Transmission Co. v. Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc.*, No. EL26-58-000 (FERC), among other commitments. A 14-day extension would not prevent the Court from considering the petition before the summer recess.

For these reasons, Respondent respectfully requests a fourteen (14) day extension of time, until May 1, 2026, to file a brief in opposition.
