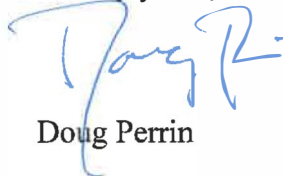
Dear Mr. Harris,

I am counsel for respondents in the above-referenced case. On March 19, 2026, a certiorari petition was docketed in this case, and on May 15, 2026, the Court requested a response. Unless extended by the Court, the response is due on June 15, 2026. For the reasons that follow, and pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of 30 days, which would result in a deadline of Wednesday, July 15, 2026.

I have and had several pressing obligations during these past and upcoming weeks, including two depositions (June 5 and 11), mediations (May 20 and June 10), a response to a Motion for Summary Judgment (June 12), discovery responses (June 5), and drafting a Petition for Review in the Texas Supreme Court (June 8). The May 20 mediation resulted in a settlement of a civil rights death case, and it has required my time to review releases and assist my clients in understanding settlement terms and their options for receipt of funds. In addition, our office in Dallas flooded over the Memorial Day weekend, requiring temporary relocation and a loss of productive time. An extension will allow me to meet these obligations and also to file a response that adequately addresses the points raised in the petition.

For these reasons, I ask that a 30-day extension be granted. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
