United States Supreme Court Rule 14.4 provides that “[t]he failure of a petitioner to present with accuracy, brevity and clarity whatever is essential to ready and adequate understanding of the points requiring consideration is sufficient reason for the Court to deny a petition...” This Supplement responds to Rule 14.4 by presenting the most accurate, brief and clear publication on the first Question Presented (truncated): “Are real estate title policies contracts of insurance?” and “Is the title insurance industry engaged in the business of insurance?”

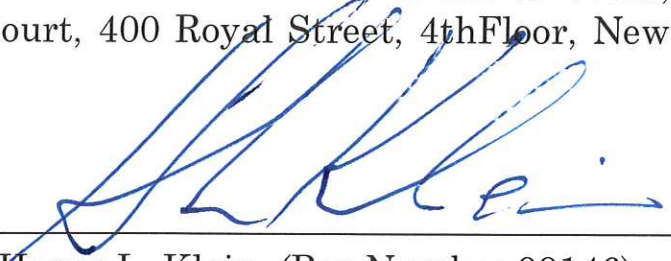
