Dear Mr. Harris:

I am appellate counsel for Allstate Insurance Company (“Respondent”) in the above-referenced matter. Andron Miguel Francis (“Petitioner”) filed his petition for writ of certiorari on or around October 14, 2025, and it was docketed on April 24, 2026. According to the online docket and pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 15.3, a response to the petition is currently due on May 26, 2026. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent respectfully requests that the time for filing a response be extended 30 days to June 25, 2026.

This is Respondent’s first request for an extension of time to file a response. Good cause exists for the requested extension. I did not represent the Respondent in the previous matters, the State Court of Gwinnett County, State of Georgia (*22-C-01840-S7*), Court of Appeals of Georgia (*A25D0341*), and the Supreme Court of Georgia (*S25C1120* & *S25D0137*), and thus require sufficient time to familiarize myself with the relevant legal issues and records.

An extension of time would further allow undersigned counsel to prepare a response that would be most helpful to the Court. Accordingly, Respondent respectfully requests that the time for filing a response to Petitioner’s petition for writ of certiorari be extended by 30 days to June 25, 2026.

In accordance with Supreme Court Rules 29 and 30.4, I have served a copy of this letter on *pro se* Petitioner of record and have contemporaneously filed a certificate of service regarding same. Thank you for your time and consideration of this matter.
