ORDER

On October 8, 2024, this case came in front of the Court for a jury trial. The Plaintiffs, Charles Randall Watts and Charles Randall Watts as Executor of the Estate of Sonya Yvonne Watts, were present with their attorney, Jud Allen. The Defendant/Cross Claimant.

Mark E. Wilson, appeared with his attorney, Doug Centeno. The Defendants, Robert T. Wilson, Jr and Wilson & Wilson Attorneys and Counselors, PC did not appear, but their attorney, Tim Allen, was present and represented both parties. After the taking of testimony and due consideration of the same, a jury of the Defendants' peers returned verdicts for the Plaintiffs and the Defendant/Cross Claimant against the Defendants.

Therefore, the Court ORDERS the following:

1. A judgment for \$200,000.00 compensatory damages and \$800,000.00 punitive damages is entered in favor of Charles Randall Watts and Charles Randall Watts as Executor of the Estate of Sonya Yvonne Watts, and against Robert T. Wilson, Jr and Wilson & Wilson Attorneys and Counselors, PC.

2. A judgment for \$200,000 compensatory damages plus \$46,862.70 prejudgment interest is entered in favor of Mark E. Wilson, and against Robert T. Wilson, Jr and Wilson & Wilson Attorneys and Counselors, PC.

Furthermore, the Court ORDERS a \$160,696.46 judgment in favor of Charles Randall Watts and Charles Randall Watts as Executor of the Estate of Sonya Yvonne Watts, and against Robert T. Wilson, Jr and Wilson & Wilson Attorneys and Counselors, PC. This judgment is reiterated from the "order on Motion for Summary Judgment in Part" entered by the Court on November 13, 2023.

All court costs are assessed against Robert T. Wilson, Jr and Wilson & Wilson Attorneys and Counselors, PC.

**ORDER ON MOTION FOR SUMMARY
JUDGMENT IN PART**

This cause came before this Court for hearing on the plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment in Part on the 22nd day of March 2023. The Court reserved ruling on said motion, and thereafter, on August 10,

2023, the plaintiff filed a Renewed Motion for Summary Judgment and Supplement to Brief and Exhibits in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment. The Court set the Renewed Motion for Summary Judgment for hearing on October 4, 2023. At said hearing, the defendants, Robert T. Wilson, Jr. and Wilson & Wilson Attorneys & Counselors, P.C., had not responded to, the Renewed Motion for Summary Judgment nor was there any evidence of material fact in dispute, but this Court gave said defendants an additional month to properly respond to the Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment, as renewed.

On November 7, 2023, this Court held a hearing on the Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment, as renewed. Present at the hearing were the plaintiffs and their attorney of record, Judson B. Allen, attorney Douglas Centeno on behalf of Mark E. Wilson, and attorney Alan Simmons on behalf of Robert T. Wilson, Jr., and Wilson & Wilson Attorneys & Counselors, P.C. Again, the Defendants provided no evidence was disputing the facts stated in the plaintiffs' motion. Upon consideration of the briefs submitted in this cause and oral argument, the Court is of the opinion that said motion for summary judgment is due to be granted as there is no genuine issue of material fact as to the issues presented in the motion and that the plaintiffs' motion is due to be granted as a matter of law. Therefore, it is ordered, adjudged, and decreed as follows:

1. Summary judgment is granted in favor of the plaintiff, Charles Randall Watts. and against Robert T. Wilson, Jr. and against Wilson & Wilson Attorneys &

Counselors, P.C. on the conversion claim of the plaintiff, Charles Randall Watts, in the amount of one hundred sixty thousand six hundred ninety-six dollars and forty-six cents (\$160,696.46) for compensatory damages.

2. This Order does not preclude the award of further compensatory damages in the way of the plaintiff=s alleged emotional distress and mental anguish nor does it preclude an award of punitive damages to the plaintiffs against the defendants in this suit in regard to the conversion claim or any other claims.

3. This Summary Judgment establishes liability on the plaintiffs= conversion claim against Robert T. Wilson, Jr. and against Wilson & Wilson Attorneys, & Counselors, P.C., and partial compensatory damages against Robert T. Wilson, Jr. and against Wilson & Wilson Attorneys & Counselors, P.C., jointly and severally, for one hundred sixty thousand six hundred ninety-six dollars and forty-six cents (\$160,696.46).
