**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISPENSE
WITH PREPARATION OF A JOINT APPENDIX**

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 26.8, Petitioners respectfully request that the Court dispense with the requirement of filing a joint appendix. Respondents do not object to this motion.

The Court granted the petition for a writ of certiorari to consider the question whether Title IX provides employees of federally funded educational institutions a private right of action to sue for sex discrimination in employment. Supreme Court Rule 26.1 provides that a joint appendix need not include any items already reproduced in the appendix to the petition for a writ of certiorari. In this case, that appendix includes the relevant materials from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit and the district courts. Petitioners believe that no other portion of the record merits special attention warranting the preparation and expense of a joint appendix

and submit that preparation and submission of a joint appendix would not materially assist the Court's consideration of this appeal.

For the foregoing reasons, the motion to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix should be granted.
