We represent Petitioners in the above-captioned case. On May 18, 2026, the Court granted the joint petition for a writ of certiorari. Under the Court's rules, Petitioners' opening brief on the merits is currently due on July 2, 2026, and Respondents' brief is due on August 3, 2026. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Petitioners write to respectfully request an extension of the merits briefing schedule to accommodate the professional and personal obligations of counsel.

Accordingly, Petitioners respectfully request that the time within which to file Petitioners' opening brief on the merits be extended to July 10, 2026, and that the time within which to file Respondents' brief be extended to August 17, 2026.
