RE: Request for extension of time to file a response to petition for writ of certiorari *Mathew Grashorn v. Wendy Love, et al.*S. Ct. No. 25-216

Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel for the respondents in this case. Petitioner Grashorn filed his petition for a writ of certiorari on August 20, 2025. On September 9, 2025, the Court requested that Respondents file response to the petition for writ of certiorari. Pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, that response is currently due on October 9, 2025. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request that the time for filing a response be extended by 31 days (as November 9 is a Sunday), **up to and including November 10, 2025**.

This is respondents' first request for an extension of time to file a response. Good cause exists for the requested extension. I am currently set to be in a two-week vehicular homicide trial in Colorado starting tomorrow and through October 3. When I get back to the office after that trial, I have several deadlines for briefs related to other civil cases.
