

Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel for the Respondent in this case. Petitioner filed his Petition for a Writ of Certiorari on September 8th, 2025. According to the online docket and pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, a Response is currently due on October 16th, 2025. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondent respectfully requests that the time for filing a response be extended by 28 days, to and including November 14th, 2025.

This is Respondent's first request for an extension of time to file a Response. Good cause exists for the requested extension, namely: the Petitioner has raised new issues in his Petition for Writ of Certiorari that were not raised in the appellate proceedings below and which require new research and analysis. An extension of time would better enable preparation of a Response that would facilitate resolution by the Supreme Court of the United States.
