Dear Mr. Harris:

Although this letter is on the letterhead of the law firm representing Respondents, it is submitted jointly on behalf of all Petitioners and Respondents.

On July 10, 2025, Respondents filed a Waiver with this Court in response to the July 7, 2025 Petition for Writ of Certiorari (“Petition”) filed by Petitioners in this case. On July 28, 2025, Respondents withdrew their Waiver and requested, with Petitioners’ consent, a 90-day extension of the deadline to respond to the Petition in light of pending settlement approval proceedings under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e) in the United States District Court for the District of Maryland. On August 8, 2025, the Court granted Respondents’ requested extension and set November 5, 2025 as the new deadline to respond to the Petition. The Court granted a second extension on November 4, 2025, through and including February 3, 2026.

The District Court’s settlement approval proceedings remain ongoing and are expected to continue for several months. In particular, the District Court preliminarily approved the settlement on December 9, 2025, and scheduled a final fairness hearing for March 30, 2026. Accordingly, to allow the settlement proceedings to play out in full, Respondents request—with Petitioners’ consent—an extension of the deadline to respond to the Petition, to **May 15, 2026**.
