MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISPENSE WITH  
PREPARATION OF A JOINT APPENDIX

Pursuant to Rule 26.8 of the Rules of this Court, the Solicitor General, on behalf of the petitioners, respectfully seeks leave to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix in this case. The question presented is whether Executive Order No. 14,160, Protecting the Meaning and Value of American Citizenship, complies on its face with the Citizenship Clause and with 8 U.S.C. 1401(a), which codifies the Clause. The opinion of the district court is appended to the petition for a writ of certiorari. In our view, no other portion of the record merits special attention

warranting the preparation and expense of a joint appendix, and preparation of a joint appendix would not materially assist the Court's consideration of this case.

Counsel for respondents has authorized us to state that respondents consent to this motion.
