
On July 23, 2025, the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States determined the July 12th petition contained deficiencies as follows:

1.) The petition is out of order, Rule 14.1. In error and on Page 1, the “Basis for Jurisdiction” was stated before the “Citations of Orders & Opinions”. As a result, they were switched without any updates to the text.

2.) The petition is out of order, Rule 14.1. The “Table of Contents” was updated to place the “Appendix (App.)”, page iii, before the “Table of Authorities” along with the items contained in the appendix that were previously on pages xi–xiii. As discussed with the Clerks Office, the Appendix Table of Contents prior to the actual appendix can remain to support the system input split between the petition and appendix.

As executed on September 18, 2025 and as required by Supreme Court Rule 33.1(h), I certify that the petition for a writ of certiorari contains 8,990 words, excluding the parts of the petition that are exempted by Supreme Court Rule 33.1(d). The petition word count remained unchanged because updates were made to the “Table of Contents” outside of the page 1 order switch.


