Dear Mr. Harris:

On behalf of Respondent Electronic Registration Information Center ("ERIC"), I write regarding the Court's request for a response to the petition for writ of certiorari filed by the Public Interest Legal Foundation, Inc. ("PILF").

ERIC was not named as a party in the underlying action. Plaintiff-Petitioner PILF brought the action against Defendant-Respondent Michigan Secretary of State Jocelyn Benson, alleging that Secretary Benson violated certain provisions of the National Voter Registration Act, 52 U.S.C. §§ 20501-20511. ERIC was involved in the case only insofar as it was served with a non-party discovery subpoena, which the district court quashed on ERIC's motion.

As PILF has expressly stated, its "petition [for writ of certiorari] does not concern the discovery disputes involving [ERIC]." (Pet. iv.) Rather, the questions presented by the petition involve solely disputes between PILF and Secretary Benson to which ERIC is not a party. Accordingly, absent contrary direction from the Court, ERIC does not intend to file a response to PILF's petition or otherwise participate in these proceedings.
