Dear Mr. Harris:

The brief in opposition to the petition for a writ of certiorari in *Michael Salazar v. Paramount Global, d/b/a 247Sports*, S. Ct. No. 25-459, is currently due to be filed on November 14, 2025. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent Paramount Global, d/b/a 247Sports (“Paramount”) respectfully requests an extension of thirty days to file its brief in opposition, to and including December 15, 2025, as the filing deadline would otherwise fall on a weekend. *See* Supreme Court Rule 30.1.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of Respondent’s opposition are currently involved with other matters, including oral arguments on November 7 and November 20, briefing deadlines on October 30, November 6, November 17, and December 4, and a mediation on November 21.

This is Paramount’s first request for an extension of time to file.
