The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on October 13, 2025. Although the government waived its right to file a response, the Court has requested that a response be filed. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on January 14, 2026. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including February 3, 2026, within which to file a response.
