Dear Mr. Harris:

We are counsel to respondents the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) and Delaware BSA LLC—the reorganized debtors in this Chapter 11 case. The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on October 14, 2025, and docketed on October 21, 2025. Respondents' response is currently due on November 20, 2025. Respondents have not previously requested an extension of time to respond to the petition. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 15.3 and 30.4, respondents now respectfully request a modest 14-day extension, to and including Thursday, December 4, 2025, to file a response to the petition. While time is of the essence in this Court's consideration of this case, as BSA and the Survivor respondents have previously described, the requested extension will not impact the date on which this Court considers the petition.

The requested extension is necessary to enable respondents to review and respond to any amicus curiae briefs that may be submitted in support of the petition. Two additional weeks would also materially support the ability of the many respondents in this complex proceeding to coordinate, with the goal of reducing the number of responses submitted to the Court.

I am authorized by counsel to state that several other respondents join in this request to extend their time to file a response to the petition: the Ad Hoc Committee of Local Councils; the Coalition of Abused Scouts for Justice; the Future Claimants' Representative; Hartford Accident and Indemnity Company, First State Insurance Company, Twin City Fire Insurance Company, and Navigators Specialty Insurance Company; Century Indemnity Company; Federal Insurance Company and Westchester Fire Insurance Company; American Zurich Insurance Company, American Guarantee Insurance Company, and Steadfast Insurance Company; Clarendon National Insurance Company, River Thames Insurance Company Limited, and Zurich American Insurance Company.

Petitioners consent to this request for BSA and all other respondents named above.
