CERTIFICATE OF PAGE COUNT FOR R. 33.2 FORMAT PETITION

When a petition for a writ of certiorari is prepared under Rule 33.1 (Booklet Format) of the Rules of this Court, it is required pursuant to Rule 33.1(h) that a certificate be included certifying that the document complies with the word count limitations laid out in Rule 33.1(g)of word count.

When a petition is prepared under Rule 33.2 (8 ½ by 11-Inch Paper Format), the Rules of this Court provide that document is limited to 40 pages. R. 33.2(b). The exclusions specified in 33.1(d) apply to the page count in documents prepared under 33.2. The 40 page limit replaces the specific word-count limit set forth in 33.1(g) for documents prepared in the 33.1 Booklet Format.

The attached petition is prepared under Rule 33.2 and is thus limited to 40 pages in the format dictated by rule, and excluding the portions indicated in 33.1(d).

Rule 33.1(h) appears to apply only to Booklet Format documents, where the length limitation is set out by word count in 33.1(g). Rule 33.2 nor its subsections require a certificate of word count or page count. However, the electronic filing system appears to require such certification be provided, regardless of whether a document is prepared under 33.1 or 33.2. As such, this certification of page count is included.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the contents of the petition, excepting the portions properly excluded under 33.1(d), do not exceed 40 pages. This is in adherence to the rules of documents prepared under Rule 33.2.
